

Planned roadworks in and around the M25: weekly summary for Monday 2 November to Sunday 8 November

The following summary of planned new and ongoing road improvements over the coming week is correct as of Thursday 29 October 2020 but could be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. M1 junction 1 Brent Cross to junction 4 Edgware, Greater London: structure maintenance

Work to maintain safety will continue this week. The southbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A41 southbound, A406 westbound to M1 junction 1.

M1 junction 3 London Gateway Services, Greater London: structure maintenance

Work to maintain safety will continue this week. The southbound entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M1 junction 4, A41 southbound, A1 southbound, A41 southbound, A406 westbound to M1 junction 1.

M4 junction 4 Heathrow (T1,2,3) & Uxbridge, Middlesex: smart motorway work

Work to improve journeys will continue this week. The westbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M4 junction 5 and return.

The eastbound entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Tuesday 3 November for 6 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M4 junction 5 and return.

M20 junction 2 Wrotham, Kent: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The eastbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 11pm and 5am, on Friday 6 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M20 junction 4 and return.

M25 junction 5 Sevenoaks, Kent: routine maintenance:

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise link road to the A21 southbound will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Monday 2 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M26 junction 2a, A20, M25 junction 3, clockwise to M25 junction 5.

The clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Monday 2 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A21 southbound and return.

M25 junction 5 Sevenoaks, Kent to junction 6 Godstone, Surrey: emergency area bays and routine maintenance

Work to improve safety by installing additional emergency areas will continue this week. The clockwise carriageway will have a 50mph speed limit in place 24 hours a day.

M25 junction 6 Godstone, Surrey: routine maintenance

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Thursday 5 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 8 and return.

M25 junction 9 Leatherhead, Surrey: carriageway repair

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Monday 2 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 8 and return

M25 junction 11 Chertsey, Surrey: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 2 November for 2 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the anti-clockwise exit and entry slip roads.

M25 junction 13 Staines, Surrey: junction improvement scheme

Work to improve journeys will continue this week. The clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 8pm and 6am, from Monday 2 November for 7 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via junction 14 and return.

M25 junction 13 Staines to A30 Crooked Billet Roundabout, Surrey: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The eastbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights. Work on Friday will start at 10pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 14, A3113, A3044.

The southern quadrant of the roundabout will be closed overnight between 8pm and 6am, from Monday 2 November for 7 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A30 southbound to Runnymede Roundabout and return.

M25 junction 14 Heathrow (T4, 5, Cargo), Middlesex: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The clockwise exit slip road and clockwise T5 spur link road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 2 November for 3 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M4 junction 5 and return.

M25 junction 19 Watford, Hertfordshire: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights.

Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 20 and the A41 southbound.

M25 junction 21a St Albans to junction 22 London Colney, Hertfordshire: carriageway repair

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Wednesday 4 November for 3 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A1081 northbound, A414 westbound, A405 westbound to M25 junction 21a.

A clearly signed diversion for M1 traffic will be in place via the A405 to M1 junction 6.

M25 junction 22 London Colney, Hertfordshire: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Monday 2 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 23 and return.

M25 junction 22 London Colney to junction 23 South Mimms, Hertfordshire: inspection work

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am on Thursday 5, and 11pm and 5:30am on Friday 6 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A1081 northbound, A414 eastbound, A1(M) southbound.

M25 junction 23 South Mimms, Hertfordshire: junction improvement work

Work to reduce congestion and improve safety as part of the Junction Improvement Programme will continue this week. The anti-clockwise exit slip road will have narrow lanes and a 50mph speed limit in place 24 hours a day.

The M25 anti-clockwise exit slip road, and southwestern quadrant of the roundabout between the A1 southbound entry slip road and M25 clockwise exit slip road, including the A1 northbound exit slip road, will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Tuesday 3 November for 6 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm.

A clearly signed diversion for the M25 anti-clockwise exit slip road will be in place via M25 junction 22 and return.

A clearly signed diversion for A1 northbound traffic to the M25 clockwise will be in place via A1(M) junction 2 and return.

A clearly signed diversion for A1 northbound traffic to the M25 anti-clockwise will be in place via A1(M) junction 2 and return, M25 junction 24 and return.

A clearly signed diversion for non-motorway traffic will be in place via Bignells Corner, Swanland Road, St Albans Road northbound, Cecil Road, Mutton Lane eastbound, Barnet Road southbound, Dancers Hill Road westbound, St Albans Road northbound.

A1 northbound non-motorway traffic will be held and safely escorted past the works.

M25 junction 23 South Mimms to junction 25 Enfield, Hertfordshire: emergency area bays

Work to improve safety by installing additional emergency areas will continue this week. The anti-clockwise carriageway will have narrow lanes and a 50mph speed limit in place 24 hours a day.

M25 junction 27 (M11) to junction 28 Brentwood, Essex: routine maintenance

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A12 southbound, A406 westbound, M11 northbound to M25 junction 27.

M25 junction 29 Romford, Essex: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The clockwise entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Saturday 7 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 28 and return.

M25 junction 31 Lakeside, Essex: bearing replacement

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The clockwise entry slip road will be closed overnight between 9pm and 9am, on Saturday 7 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 30 and return.

A1(M) junction 1 South Mimms, Hertfordshire: junction improvement

Work to reduce congestion and improve safety as part of the Junction Improvement Programme will continue this week. The southbound entry slip road will have narrow lanes and a 50mph speed limit in place 24 hours a day.

A1(M) junction 2 Welham Green to junction 4 Hertford, Hertfordshire: routine maintenance

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The southbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am on Tuesday 3, and 11pm and 5am on Friday 6 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A1001 Comet Way to A1(M) junction 2.

A1(M) junction 3 Hatfield to junction 4 Hertford, Hertfordshire: routine maintenance

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The northbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Tuesday 3 November for 3 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A1001 Comet Way to A1(M) junction 4.

A13 (M25), Essex: waterproofing and resurfacing work

Work to improve journeys will continue this week. The westbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 9pm and 10am, on Saturday 7 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the westbound exit and entry slip roads.

A30 Crooked Billet roundabout, Surrey: junction improvement

Work to reduce congestion and improve safety as part of the Junction Improvement Programme will continue this week.

A30 Crooked Billet Roundabout to M25 junction 13 Staines, Surrey: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will continue this week. The westbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 8pm and 6am, from Monday 2 November for 7 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A3044 Stanwell Moor Road northbound, A3113 Airport Way to M25 junction 14.

**A40 Denham Roundabout, Denham Road to M40 eastbound exit slip road
Buckinghamshire: structure repair**

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The clockwise roundabout will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 2 November for 2 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the anti-clockwise roundabout.

**A40 Denham Roundabout, Denham Court Drive to Oxford Road
Buckinghamshire: electrical work**

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The clockwise roundabout will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Wednesday 4 November for 2 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the anti-clockwise roundabout.

A282 (M25) junction 1b Dartford, Kent: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will continue this week. The clockwise entry slip road and anti-clockwise exit slip road and dedicated link road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via A282 junction 1a and return.

A282 (M25) Dartford – Thurrock Crossing: routine maintenance

Work to maintain safety by carrying out routine maintenance at the Dartford Crossing continues this week. The following closures will be in place overnight between 10pm and 5am, with fully signed diversions in place during the northbound east tunnel closures for oversized vehicles:

- Saturday 7 November – Northbound East Tunnel
- Sunday 8 November – Northbound East Tunnel

A282, QEII Bridge

The QEII Bridge will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:00am, on Saturday 7 November. Southbound traffic will be diverted through the east tunnel.

A406 (M11), Greater London: bridge joint replacements

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The eastbound link road to the M11 northbound will be closed over the weekend, from 10pm on Friday 6 November to 5am on Monday 9 November. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A406 eastbound to Redbridge Roundabout and return.

A1089 (A13), Essex: inspection work

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The northbound link road to the A13 eastbound will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 2 November for 5 nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A13 westbound, A1012 and return.

Safety at roadworks

Highways England is working with the industry and road users to reduce the risks of working on the roads. For the safety of road workers and all road users when you are approaching roadworks:

- Keep within the speed limit – it is there for your safety.
- Get into the correct lane in good time – don't keep switching.
- Concentrate on the road ahead, not the roadworks.
- Be alert for works' traffic leaving or entering roadworks.
- Keep a safe distance – there could be queues in front.
- Observe all signs – they are there to help you.
- And be alert for road workers, the roads are their workplace.
