

Planned roadworks in and around the M25: weekly summary for Monday 11 January to Sunday 17 January

The following summary of planned new and ongoing road improvements over the coming week is correct as of Thursday 7 January 2021 but could be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. M1 junction 1 Brent Cross to junction 2 Mill Hill, Greater London: structure maintenance

Work to maintain safety will continue this week. The northbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A406 eastbound, A41 northbound to M1 junction 2.

M1 junction 1 Brent Cross to junction 4 Edgware, Greater London: structure maintenance

Work to maintain safety will continue this week. The southbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A41, A1, A41 southbound, A406 westbound to junction 1.

M1 junction 3 London Gateway Services, Greater London: structure maintenance

Work to maintain safety will continue this week. The southbound entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M1 junction 4, the A41, A1, A41 southbound, A406 westbound to junction 1.

M1 junction 6 Bricket Wood, Hertfordshire: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The northbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M1 junction 8 and return.

M3 junction 2 (M25), Surrey: inspection work

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The eastbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 11pm and 5am, on Friday 15 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 11 and return.

M4 junction 4 Heathrow (T1, 2, 3) & Uxbridge to A408 Cherry Lane roundabout, Middlesex: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The southbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for seven nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via Holloway Lane, Hatch Lane, A4 West Ramp, and junction 4 Spur Road.

M4 junction 4a Heathrow (T1, 2, 3), Middlesex: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The eastbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via East Ramp.

M4 junction 4b (M25), Middlesex: structure maintenance

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The westbound and eastbound link roads to the M25 anti-clockwise will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Monday 11 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 16 and return.

M20 junction 1 (M25), Kent: structure maintenance

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The westbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five

nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 3, junction 2, A2, A205 to Crittalls Corner.

M25 junction 2 (A2), Kent: signage work

Work to keep users informed will start this week. The anti-clockwise exit slip road and anti-clockwise link road to the A2 westbound will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am on Monday 11 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via A282 junction 1a and return.

M25 junction 3 Swanley, Kent: routine maintenance and carriageway repair

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Monday 11 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 4 and return.

M25 junction 6 Godstone to junction 7 (M23), Surrey: structure inspections

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, on Monday 11, Saturday 16, and Sunday 17 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A22 northbound, A23 southbound to M25 junction 7.

M25 junction 12 (M3), Surrey: bridge joint replacements

Work to maintain journeys will continue this week. The M25 anti-clockwise link road to the M3 westbound will be closed overnight between from 10pm and 5:30am, from Wednesday 13 January for three nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the M3 eastbound to junction 1 and return.

M25 junction 13 Staines, Surrey: structure inspections

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The clockwise entry slip road and anti-clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Wednesday 13 January for two nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 11 and return.

M25 junction 14 Heathrow (T4, 5, Cargo) to Terminal 5 Spur Road, Middlesex: structure repair and signage work

Work to keep users informed will start this week. The Terminal 5 Spur Road westbound carriageway and clockwise entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 11 January for two nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 13 and return.

The anti-clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Tuesday 12 January for three nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 13 and return.

M25 junction 15 (M4), Middlesex: smart motorway work

Work to improve journeys will continue this week. The clockwise link road to the M4 westbound will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Wednesday 13 January for two nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M4 junction 4 and return.

M25 junction 16 (M40), Buckinghamshire: structure inspections

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The clockwise link road to the M40 westbound will be closed overnight between 11pm and 5am on Friday 15, and 10pm and 5am on Saturday 16 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 17 and return.

M25 junction 18 Chorleywood to junction 20 Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire: routine maintenance

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Monday 11 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A41 southbound, A411 southbound, A412 westbound, A404 northbound to M25 junction 18.

M25 junction 23 South Mimms, Hertfordshire: junction improvement work

Work to reduce congestion and improve safety as part of the Junction Improvement Programme will continue this week. The anti-clockwise exit slip road will have narrow lanes and a 50mph speed limit in place 24 hours a day.

The inbound and outbound carriageways at Bignells Corner will be closed between 10pm and 6am, from Monday 11 January for 5 nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 22, B556, St Albans Road to Bignells Corner and the Motorway Services Area.

The anti-clockwise exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am on Wednesday 13 and Saturday 16 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 22 and return.

The anti-clockwise entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10:30pm and 5am, on Sunday 17 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 24 and return.

M25 junction 24 Potters Bar, Hertfordshire: routine maintenance

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise entry and exit slip roads will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Tuesday 12 January.

A clearly signed diversion for the anti-clockwise entry slip road will be in place via M25 junction 25 and return.

A clearly signed diversion for the anti-clockwise exit slip road will be in place via M25 junction 23 and return.

M25 junction 25 Enfield, Hertfordshire: routine maintenance

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The clockwise entry and exit slip roads will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Thursday 14 January.

A clearly signed diversion for the clockwise entry slip road will be in place via M25 junction 24 and return.

A clearly signed diversion for the clockwise exit slip road will be in place via M25 junction 26 and return.

The anti-clockwise entry and exit slip roads will be closed overnight between 11pm and 5am, on Friday 15 January.

A clearly signed diversion for the anti-clockwise entry slip road will be in place via M25 junction 26 and return.

A clearly signed diversion for the anti-clockwise exit slip road will be in place via M25 junction 24 and return.

M25 junction 26 Waltham Abbey to junction 27 (M11), Essex: structure inspections

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Wednesday 13 January for four nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A121, Epping New Road, A406 Eastbound, M11 northbound to M25 junction 27.

M25 junction 27 (M11), Essex: Inspection work

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The anti-clockwise link road to the M11 southbound will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M11 junction 7 and return.

M25 junction 27 (M11) to junction 28 Brentwood, Essex: carriageway repair

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The anti-clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A12, Redbridge Roundabout, A406, M11 to M25 junction 27.

M25 junction 29 Romford, Essex: carriageway repair

Work to maintain journeys will continue this week. The northern quadrant of the roundabout will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 28 and return.

M25 junction 30 Thurrock, Essex: structure inspections

Work to maintain journeys will continue this week. The clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the clockwise exit and entry slip roads.

The clockwise entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, on Saturday 16 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via M25 junction 30 and return.

A1(M) junction 1 South Mimms, Hertfordshire: junction improvement and routine maintenance

Work to reduce congestion and improve safety as part of the Junction Improvement Programme will continue this week. The southbound entry slip road will have narrow lanes and a 50mph speed limit in place 24 hours a day.

The southbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am on Thursday 14, and 11pm and 5am on Friday 15 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the southbound exit and entry slip roads.

A13 (M25) Essex: electrical work, waterproofing and surfacing work

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The westbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 9pm and 10am, on Saturday 16 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A1306 and return.

The westbound entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am on Saturday 16, and 10:30pm and 5am on Sunday 17 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A126 and return.

A13 (A1012), Essex: environmental work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The eastbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the Orsett Cock roundabout and return.

A12 (A1306), Essex: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The westbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am on Saturday 16, and 10:30pm and 5am on Sunday 17 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via Ferry Lane and return.

A20 (M20), Kent: inspection work

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The westbound entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A20, A225, A25, A224 to Crittalls Corner.

A20 Sidcup Bypass to M25 junction 3 Swanley, Kent: carriageway repair

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The eastbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A205, A2 to M25 junction 3.

A23 Brighton Road to M23 junction 8 (M25), Surrey: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The southbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am on Thursday 14, and 11pm and 5am on Friday 15 January. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A23, A25, A217, M25 junction 8 to M25 junction 7.

A30 Crooked Billet roundabout, Surrey: junction improvement

Work to reduce congestion and improve safety as part of the Junction Improvement Programme will continue this week.

A282 (M25) junction 1a Swanscombe, Kent: tunnel maintenance

Work to maintain safety by carrying out tunnel maintenance will continue this week. The anti-clockwise entry slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 11 January for three nights. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via junction 1b and return.

A282 (M25) junction 1a Swanscombe to M25 junction 2 (A2), Kent: electrical work

Work to maintain journeys will start this week. The clockwise carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via A206 Crossways Boulevard, B255, A2 westbound to M25 junction 2.

A282 junction 1b (M25) Dartford, Kent: barrier repair

Work to maintain safety will start this week. The southbound exit slip road will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via A282 junction 1a, A206 Crossways Boulevard, B255, A2 westbound to M25 junction 2.

A282 (M25) Dartford – Thurrock Crossing: routine maintenance

Work to maintain safety by carrying out routine maintenance at the Dartford Crossing continues this week. The following closures will be in place overnight between 10pm and 5am, with fully signed diversions in place during the northbound east tunnel closures for oversized vehicles:

nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A405 southbound, Horseshoe Lane westbound, Woolside Road northbound, Chequers Lane eastbound.

A clearly signed diversion for motorway traffic will be in place via the A405 southbound, A41 westbound, northbound to M25 junction 20.

A405 Bucknalls Lane to Chequers Lane, Hertfordshire: surfacing work

Work to improve journeys will start this week. The eastbound carriageway will be closed overnight between 10pm and 5:30am, from Monday 11 January for five nights. Work on Friday will start at 11pm. A clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A405 southbound, Horseshoe Lane westbound, Woolside Road northbound, Chequers Lane eastbound.

A clearly signed diversion for motorway traffic will be in place via the A405 southbound, A41 westbound, northbound to M25 junction 20.

Safety at roadworks

Highways England is working with the industry and road users to reduce the risks of working on the roads. For the safety of road workers and all road users when you are approaching roadworks:

- Keep within the speed limit – it is there for your safety.
- Get into the correct lane in good time – don't keep switching.
- Concentrate on the road ahead, not the roadworks.
- Be alert for works' traffic leaving or entering roadworks.
- Keep a safe distance – there could be queues in front.
- Observe all signs – they are there to help you.
- And be alert for road workers, the roads are their workplace.
